### **Eligibility Requirements**

The VFW Auxiliary is pleased to present scholarships to assist members and their immediate family members who wish to further their education by pursing a college degree or career direction at a vocational/technical school.

#### Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year, one in each of the four VFW Auxiliary Conferences.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the American college or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice.

- Applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- Applicant must be one of the following:
  - Current VFW Auxiliary Member\*
  - Spouse of current VFW Auxiliary Member\*
  - Son of current VFW Auxiliary Member\*
  - Daughter of current VFW Auxiliary Member\*

\*Qualifying member must have been a member of the VFW Auxiliary for one (1) year by the application submission deadline.

### **The Application Process**

A completed application must be submitted for each individual seeking a Continuing Education Scholarship from the VFW Auxiliary. Each applicant must:

- Answer all guestions on the application.
- Write a brief essay (no more than 300 words) describing their commitment to their goals and how this scholarship will help them attain these goals.

## **Application Tips**

Here are some tips to keep in mind throughout the process:

- · Be mindful of the eligibility requirements.
- Answer ALL questions on the application.
- Applications are due at VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters no later than February 15. Applications received after February 15 will not be considered.

### **Application Timeline**
